

The club treated 15 members to 5 pizzas. While eating, Chris kindly showed a video




tape of his ham radio exploits in Antarctica which were not



#### Successful Weather Drill

A severe weather drill was held on Thursday March 21, 2002 and RACES was activated. At 0900, an Eastern PA Net was activated on 3.993.5 MhZ with K2KR as net control. The Lehigh County EOC as well as some of us who operated from home had a good copy both ways, with the EPA Net.

At 1030, the EPA moved to 7.250.5 MhZ as propagation was failing on 75 meters. On the Lehigh County level, the EOC was manned by Jeff (N3MFT), Jim (KA3UQP) and Chris (N3SIG) and the [local] net was activated at 1003.

Mobile and base check-ins included Bruce (KA3ONZ), Chris (N3RPV), Ed (KD3NH), Carl (WA6VSE - *now WK3C*), Robin (KB3GZV), Bill (KA3RBH), Carl (AA3IX) and Erik (AI3D).

Several simulated reports were filed including high winds in the route 100 and Macungie area. Also, a tornado touched down in Allentown at Emaus avenue and Mack Blvd. Both areas were checked and damage reported. Mt. Holly [National Weather Service] issued a flash flood watch for Lehigh County.

At 1155, the Lehigh County Net closed. At 1157, we secured from the EPA Net.
