Minutes of the February 5, 2008 LVARC Meeting

Submitted by Rod (N3XG) in Phil's Absence

The February meeting of the LVARC / W3OI was called to order by President Wolfe at 19:30 EST, on February 5, 2008. The following board members were in attendance: President Wolfe, Treasurer Ryan, Board Members Robin Gable, Walt Snyder, Larry Snyder, and Frank Unger. There were 20 members in attendance and the club welcomed 3 guests. The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag followed by a moment of silence.

There were no corrections or additions to the January minutes as printed in the EVOX and the minutes stood approved.

N0KIA read the treasure's report and indicated we started February with a balance of 3,834.90. A motion from Larry KN3L accepted the treasures report and Walt KE3SP made a second to the motion with all in favor.

President Wolfe reported on the "white noise" that people are hearing on the 135 repeater pair. That is the sound of the D-Star repeater, which is currently operating on the same pair from the same site. The D-Star repeater will be moving to a different frequency pair, for the 2-meter repeater only.

Phil was out with illness and sent in a program report to N3XG. President Wolfe reported for Phil that the club would be having a dinner get together at the Old Country Buffet in Whitehall, starting at 1800 hours on February 27 (a Wednesday night). Tonight's program will be Rodney N3XG with a demonstration on the D-Star digital mode. Next month (March), John KB3PJO will be presenting the "other side of BPL".

The VE report was also sent into N3XG due to a work commitment on the part of Mark AK3M. Mark reported that at the January test session there was one new license earned and two upgrades. The club wishes to congratulate Brian Snyder (a KE3SP harmonic) for earning the call sign KB3QHA, and congratulations to both Brian KB3PJP and Malcolm KG4ANI for upgrading to Extra Class. It was also mentioned that Malcolm drove from Maryland to take his upgrade at our test session.

President Wolfe reported that the Board held their annual meeting at his QTH on January 11. The board reviewed several fund raising items. New Business

President Wolfe introduced a proposed change to the Bylaws. President Wolfe presented a change in the way the members are defined and accepted into the club. There was much discussion on this proposal, and President Wolfe reminded everyone to carefully read and consider the wording of the change, as it needs to be read twice and printed once, prior to a vote.

Under Good of the Order, Ike N3IK informed the club members of the FISTS organization, that is for code enthusiasts, and for those that wish to learn more and become more proficient in the code.

Bruce KA3TIU made a motion to close the meeting, and Larry KN3L made a second with all in favor. The meeting closed at 2035 EST.

D. To be an associate member, it is not necessary to hold an amateur license.
Proposed change:
C. To be an associate member, one must be current of dues and have been voted into the club by majority vote at time of membership application. Associate members need not hold an amateur license.
D. To be an active member, one must be current of dues and have been voted into the active membership by majority vote after attending no less than two club meetings within any 12-month period after acceptance as an associate member Active members must hold a valid amateur license issued by the FCC.
