KUDOS to the LVARC ARES Operators!

After the "St. Joseph The Worker 4 Miler Run, "I was reviewing the event and deciding what to write for the newsletter. It occurred to me that we are all pretty much aware of what we do as operators for an ARES event but what about the personal side of our job? We are, of course, people first, then ham operators. After all, we all were people many years before we became hams. It is impossible for us to forget our personal side and it shows in our behavior as communications support operators for an event. After the 4-mile Run, I noticed "Above and Beyond," actions by our operators. Don (W3DLH), for one, waited until all runners had passed his position and on his own, acted as a "sweep" vehicle to be sure that no one was left behind. In addition, he picked up all the water cups which were left in the street on the course! He could have left his position for home but decided to go beyond his communications duty.

I only use Don as an example because his actions are fresh in my mind but this kind of behavior happens all the time and it reflects the character of our operators. When we participate in a "non-charitable," event like the 1/2 marathon. I am frequently asked about the "stragglers?" When we do participate in those kind of activities, usually, we are dismissed after the majority of the runners finish. This is difficult for our operators who are people first. When we participate in a, "charitable," event, we see the caring side of our operators.

I am very very proud of our ARES operators !!! The character and behavior of these people/operators is good for our hobby, club as it shows what kind of people become hams!!!


THE NEW LEHIGH COUNTY EOC
