




 $oldsymbol{T}$ echnology has come a long way. Printers are now (and have been for a while) very inexpensive and provide much better quality than the old days of dot matrix printers. Unfortunately, these newer, better printers require ink which, as we all know, come in cartridges. Also, as we all know, these cartridges can be very expensive. I have heard that to purchase a full set of ink for a printer, cost one LVARC member as much as \$65.00! I don't know how long that ink will last him but it is the price that I want to address. HP has a wireless printer, scanner and copy machine in one, that sells for \$69.99. If one were to purchase a copier, scanner and printer separately, they would pay much more than that. In addition, the new HP comes with ink. Let's see \$65.00 vs. \$70.00. It would seem that when one needs more ink, he should simply buy, not ink cartridges, but rather new printer hardware. Sounds ridiculous but the facts workout to indicate that buying a new printer would cost as much as replacing ink in your old printer.

TIP:

Counterpoise wires: Rather than carry 4 or 6 different length counterpoise wires cut for different bands, get TV rotor wire (usually 4 or 6 wires connected together). Cut each one to the length you need.



Due to the weather that canceled the February 1 LVARC meeting, L.C. EMA requested that RACES activate a **RACES Severe WX Net.** On Tuesday February 1, 2011, began a directed net at 0900 (EST). Eighteen stations checked in and indicated their availability for deployment or willingness to act as a net control station. Two stations



indicated that they were prepared and willing to deploy to the EOC or shelter(s) if needed. Five stations were willing to help as control operators. Those who checked in included, KB3QZL, WB3JSZ, N3GRH, KB3GZV, W3HA, N3MFT, N3XG, KA3RBH, KW3K, KC9DQV, W3QXI, NR3R, KB2UZE, KB3MQD, WB3W, K3ANS, KV3C and KA3WNT.

There were 19 pieces of traffic exchanged, all of a routine nature. The traffic was related to the current weather and road conditions status. No deployment was required for this event.

A message from the EMA director came at 12:16 suggesting that the net close and reopen in the early evening due to continued forecasts of bad weather including the arrival of ice. Rod (N3XG) took over as NCS at 12:15 (EST) and closed the net at 12:17 pm.
