



Women's 5K Classic a Huge Success

On a beautiful day in October (October 18), no rain, wet snow or sleet, **twenty one** LVARC operators turned out to provide communications support for the **Women's 5K Classic** in the Lehigh Parkway. More than 4,500 women ran or walked to support this fund raiser for breast cancer research. I have been told, this is the largest event of its kind on the East coast! LVARC operators arrived shortly after sunrise and all were in position much before the start time. A directed net was opened at 0836 and the 146.94 repeater was the primary machine used with 146.135 as a back up. The net closed at 1105.

Traffic handled included all categories, mostly routine but there were two regarding, "downed," runners, one which required EMS support. The other was not found by our operator (Stephen - KC3BQF) or two paramedics on bicycles.

All LVARC operators acted as professionally as amateurs can. I am proud of the dedication LVARC ARES operators show in all community events!
