Committee Reports: Repeater: The club board met and established a troubleshooting plan for the 147.135 machine to eliminate the hum.Step 1: Rod (N3XG) will replace the tone board with a spare he owns. Step 2: If required, Paul (N0KIA) is building a replacement controller and that will be installed in place of the existing controller.

Once the problem is isolated, the final fix proposal will be brought to the club membership for approval.

Club Station: The club has been offered a 10' X 10' room in the basement of the firehouse. It is close to power panels, and the outside wall and has roof access. The room was the old beer cooler room, which is no longer in use. The room has large wooden door. The fire company is more than willing to provide this space. Once the basement is finished, there will shower and bunk facilities for over night use if needed by the club. The club will need to outfit the room.

Program: Paul will present a program tonight on useful HT accessories. The hands on night will feature the same topic. Nest month Rod (N3XG) will have a program on Log Book of the World and eQSL.

There is no inexpensive way to install the equipment. The equipment will be offered for sale to club members' first (Sept 1 to Sept 15) then DLARC club members (Sept 16 to Sept 25). Any leftover equipment will be sold on eBay. Myles (KB3ZMA) will have pictures of the equipment to show interested buyers.

A request was made of a Holiday Party chairman for December. The Holiday party this year will not be held the same night as the regularly scheduled business meeting. The party will be held on December 16, 2014, the night of the December hands on meeting night. The party is open to guests. The raffle and awards will be part of the party. Interested member are to contact Rod (N3XG).

Once the club station is established the Board has decided to pursue a mobile station in a trailer. The club owns sufficient radios to outfit a fixed and mobile station. The mobile station is more in line with traditional club activities. Once tax-free status is established, Rod (N3XG) believes that we can obtain a trailer from PEMA.

If members are asked to represent the LVARC at public events, they are asked to notify the Board before attending the event.

Rex reported that the Cetronia parade went well and the parade organizer thanked Rex for efforts.

New Business:

Next year Rod (N3XG) And Brian (KW3K) will not be running for club office next year. Club members should start thinking abut nominees for club President and Vice President in October.

Good of the Order: Rex thanked various club members for bring information on the digital modes to the general membership. Rex has enjoyed using these new modes.






