


12 Volt Emergency Light Box



Last month, in the March, 2015 VOX, I showed a picture of my \$1.00 wooden cigar box that I said I was going to use to make a 12v emergency light box. I had some 12v LED panels and 12v battery holders left over from previous projects, so I decided to make this box using my purchase of the cigar box from Cigars *International*. I said I would post a picture of this box when it was completed.

The box consists of three 12v LED exterior automotive "driving lights" and three 12v LED panels, each panel consisting of 48 LED's. Each light panel is independent and can be turned on/off separately. Toggle switches that control the panel's function, are located on the top of the box. Each panel is also powered by 3-A23 12v batteries connected in parallel. The total voltage to each panel is still 12 volts but will last 3 times as long as a single battery. Replacing the batteries are easy as the battery holders are mounted inside the box.





THIS JUST IN No more paper licenses in the mail automatically. You can still get one if you ask for it. The important thing for the test, appears to be to include an email address --- then you get an "official copy." You can however, print a reference copy for yourself. (see page 15).

Print Your License - de Mark (AK3M)

On page 14, Mike (KC3BLF), reports that FCC **paper licenses will no longer be issued.** You CAN however, get a printed/hard copy of your license but you must print it yourself.

With information being shared electronically, this is understandable and not surprising but *how does one go about printing his license?*

TNX to Charlie (KC5EZZ) http://www.w5qx.org/download_license.html who provides the answer. Use the following if you want to print your *Reference Copy* FCC issued ham license.

- 1. Go to http://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsApp/UlsSearch/searchLicense.jsp
- 2. Search for your call sign.
- 3. Click on your call sign
- 4. Click on the ADMIN tab
- 5. Click on "Authorization -- Licensee"



6. Your reference copy license will open in a PDF file for printing or saving.
