



### Another Successful Women's 5K Classic!

On Saturday October 17, 2015, the weather was very cool but the sun was out as **fourteen** members of the LVARC made their way to the largest breast cancer fundraising event on the East coast. The LVARC has provided communications support for this event for about twelve or more years. The event coordinators have come to rely on this support and our operators have stepped up and volunteered as they always have. TNX and kudos to them. Without operators volunteering their time and expertise, amateur radio participation would not be possible and we could not offer our service to local events.

More than 3,000 women walked or ran the 3.2 mile course to raise money for breast cancer research and treatment, many of them, survivors of the disease themselves.

LVARC operators met as a group at 0800 and dispersed a short time later to there assigned positions. Missi, the event coordinator had a golf cart at our disposal and Larry (NR3R), was able to take operators to remote sites. A directed net was opened at 0845 with a pink sea or women participants either running or walking more than three miles for a great cause! Our operators were on scene providing, "Eyes On The Course," ready to provide communication assistance. The net closed at 1131.

Net control was parked with the EMS vehicles for immediate medical communication from our operators. There was one medical emergency handled by Kenny (KC3BLE) for a spectator who fell. EMS was dispatched and all went well.

I wish to thank the following LVARC operators who took time out of their busy Saturday to offer their time and communication expertise for this event. **Mark** (AK3M), Larry (NR3R), Phil (KB3HMK), Don (W3DLH), Don (N0VGA), Andy (KC3EKA), John (KB3PJO), John (KB3VNS), Alan (KB3TYE), Stephen (W3TNT), Bob (WB3JSZ), Kenny (KC3BLE), and Igor (KC3ASC), Dave (W3AMC) joined the group from home as a standby operator should land line communications be necessary.








#### Clement Clarke Moore 1779 ~ 1863

**Moore was born** on July 15, 1779, in a large mansion, on his parents' Chelsea estate that encompassed the area that is now 18th to 24th Streets between Eighth and Tenth Avenues in Manhattan.

He became a well-known and respected scholar and, typical for an educated person of his period, Moore's publications related to a wide variety of topics such as religion, languages, politics, and poetry.



When he wrote <u>A Visit from St. Nicholas</u> in 1822, Moore was a Professor of Oriental and Greek Literature, as well as Divinity and Biblical Learning, at the General Theological Seminary of the Protestant Episcopal Church. Located on land donated by the "Bard of Chelsea" himself.

OK, what is this? NBEMS is "Narrow Band Emergency Messaging Service". If you operate digital modes on HF at all, you probably have used the main tool of NBEMS whether you knew it or not. FLDigi, free ham software that runs on Windows, Mac or Linux is the program generally used for NBEMS. It can use a wide range of digital waveforms into and out of your radio to send text messages, computer files or even pictures. While most think of this as an HF radio activity, it also works very well (actually, even better!) on VHF or UHF. You can use it through a repeater, simplex, connected to a radio with a cable or just using "acoustic coupling" by holding the radio speaker near the computer microphone to receive and holding the radio mic near the computer speaker to transmit.

You can type your own message to send, or send and receive actual ICS 213 (and several other) forms. All this is possible with an HT and nearly any kind of computer (even a cheap Windows tablet—under \$100.00).

If you are looking to hear some activity on NBEMS, here are a couple nets local to us where you can listen and transmit every week:

Also, did you know Voice of America transmits a picture every week along with their voice broadcast? It's in MSFK mode (part of FLDigi). "The Mighty KBC" and other shortwave broadcasts also do this. They know many of their listeners are hams and can decode the image. In case you are a shortwave listener and wondered what those modem tones were you were hearing.
