

This comes up often, especially with Spring and Summer events nearing and new hams joining the LVARC all the time. With this in mind, it is a good time for a brief review.

RACES is administered at the <u>county</u> level and ARES is an <u>ARRL</u> sponsored organization. If you are not registered with Lehigh County RACES, you <u>cannot</u> participate in any events when the <u>county</u> solicits our help for communications support.

To be a RACES member and participate in RACES events, you must have passed **ICS 100** <u>and</u> **ICS 700**. **NO** certifications are needed to participate in an ARES event.

To volunteer for an ARES event, you simply need to contact the LVARC ARES coordinator when an event is scheduled and the event staff requests communication support. These events are posted in the VOX and announced at meetings and on the Monday Night Net, as they are scheduled.

I have a list of those who have ICS certifications (provided you sent it to me) but NOT a list of those who are registered with Lehigh County as RACES members. If you have ICS certifications 100 and 700 and/or RACES registrations, let me know. I will develop a list of L.C. RACES members for 2015.

"Kerchunking" the Repeater Is NOT Good Practice (and is really illegal)

On the LVARC web site, are guidelines for repeater use. The specific reference to "kerchunking" the repeater is item #9 and is presented below.

Monday ARES/RACES/LVARC net a 7:30 PM local on the 146.94/146.34 (71.9 Hz) Repeater
View the club's REPEATER GUIDLINES (Test-only version)

9. Signal Reports and Kerchunking. If you are unsure how well you are making it into the repeater, DO NOT kerchunk the repeater. Any time you key up the repeater, you should identify, even if you are just testing to see if you are making the machine. "[Callsign] test" is sufficient. Do not use the repeater as a "target" for tuning or aiming antennas, checking your transmitter power, etc. Use a dummy load where appropriate, or test on a simplex frequency. If you need someone to verify that you are making the repeater OK, ask for a signal report such as "This is [Callsign], looking for a signal report?"





TIP from AAA: If you are ever in an accident, **NEVER** say, "**I'm sorry**!" Wait for the police to make their report. You **SHOULD** take pictures and exchange personal and insurance.
