

2015 LVARC ARES & VE In Review

During the 2015 year, the LVARC continued to provide communications support for community events (ARES) and administer ham radio tests!

ARES Program: The LVARC provided communications for 7 community events (ARES) in 2015.

VE Program: The LVARC VE team held **10** test sessions in 2015 (including Field Day), tested a total of **44** people and collected **\$371.00**.

A review of the LVARC VE program shows that since the program started in 2003, **129** test sessions were held, **395** people were tested and a total of **\$2,650.00** was earned for the LVARC VE program.


Party A Huge Success! the party included food, incentive ticket drawings, conversation and the presentation of the Pres Schuler award.








