

2020 ARES Report

Due to COVID 19, **NO** ARES events were held in 2020. The LVARC ARES program provided no communications support for community events this year.

2020 VE Report


The LVARC In QST!

Two items in the December 2020 issue of QST are related to the LVARC.




Last month, Larry's (NR3R) 30 WPM CW achievement was posted. On page 83 of the December 2020 issue of QST, is the official *Certificate of*
