Committee Reports:

Repeater: Rod (N3XG) had the following report. Thanks to the very hard work of Richard KC3FEZ and Jeff WA3PNY, the DSTAR stack MOD C now can connect to the XLX045 Server, which contains PA Cross Link. For those of you that are not familiar with this, that means that all flavors of digital are now able to speak to each other in the Lehigh Valley. DSTAR, DMR, YSF, and P25.

Program: Tonight will be John (AB3LZ) doing a presentation on Antennas 101. Next month is unknown. It is normally Field Day prep. Due to not knowing if we will be having Field Day, the program is not known at this time. John suggested that he could do a follow up to the presentation he's doing tonight.

Volunteer Examiners: Mark (AK3M) had the following to report. Presently, there are 15 people wishing to test. They have agreed to be placed on a waiting list and will be notified when the LVARC resumes its testing program. From the W3OI trustee, here's data on how to get a copy of your license from the FCC database. Thanks Carl!

The FCC no longer mails license authorizations. If you provide an email address on your application, a link to print your official copy of your license will be automatically emailed to you when the application has been granted.



Licensees can also opt to download electronic authorizations by logging into ULS License Manager:

https://wireless2.fcc.gov/UlsEntry/licManager/login.jsp

and login with your FCC Registration Number (FRN) and password. After entering your password, proceed to the steps for "Download Electronic Authorizations".
