Test sessions will be scheduled when enough applicants are on the waiting list.



WX Terms

We all have heard the following weather terms but do you know what they mean?

RADAR INDICATED means that a weather occurrence has **NOT** yet been seen *visually* but can be seen on radar.

A **WATCH** means that conditions are favorable for a weather event (tornado, thunderstorm etc.) to happen.

A **WARNING** means that a weather event is **PROBABLE**.

The NOAA weather frequencies are:

WX1 - 162.550	WX5 - 162.450
WX2 - 162.400	WX6 - 162.500
WX3 - 162.475	WX7 - 162.525
WX4 - 162.420	


The local (Lehigh Valley) WX frequency is 162.40 MHz.

Net Tip

During the reading of the preamble to the LVARC Monday Night Net, there is text that says, "Stations with routine traffic," can call NCS now." That would be the time to state any traffic you have.

There is no need to respond with, "No Traffic," when you are called during roll call.

If you had traffic, you should have stated it during the request in the preamble.



Why the U.S. Coast Guard Recommends VHF Radio for Emergencies Instead of Cell Phones

I just returned from my annual week at the beach where I took my Baofeng to monitor VHF marine frequencies. In fact, when I owned my boat, I had an opportunity to us VHF to summon help.

Why does the U.S. Coast Guard recommend VHF comms over using cell phones? There are two reasons. The first is that if you need help while on a boat, when you call for help on channel 16 (156.800 MHz), there is a chance that many boats will hear you and be able offer assistance as channel 16 is required listening if you have a VHF radio on your boat.

The second reason is that you may not be in range of a cell tower while on the water and your cell phone will be ineffective. Cell phones are limited to 1/2 watt as marine VHF radios can use up to 25 watts.

FCC Amateur Radio License Fee Increase



The FCC license fee increase is still an active issue **but reportedly has not yet been initiated** ... yet. The fees are expected to increase to \$35.00.

Once it's effective, the \$35 application fee will apply to new, modification (upgrade and sequential call sign change), renewal, and vanity call sign applications. All fees will be per application.

Administrative update applications, such as those to change a licensee's name, mailing, or email address, will be exempt from fees. ARRL VEC manager Maria Somma, AB1FM, said Volunteer Examiner (VE) teams will not face the burden of collecting the \$35 fee.

The new estimate is that the fees won't go into effect until early next year.
