

Steps to Filing a Request to Renew a License in ULS

- 1. Log in to ULS Online Filing with your FCC Registration Number (FRN) and password. ...
- 2. On the left-side of the screen, click Renew Licenses.
- 3. Select the licenses and Click Add.
- 4. Click Continue to navigate through the application.

How Do I Get A Personalized PA License Plate?

To apply for a standard personalized registration plate, **Form MV-904 (PDF)**, "Application for Special Registration Plate," must be completed. Personalized registration plate applicants must have a valid registration plate, which the applicant



shall retain pending receipt of the requested personal plate.


