A **NEW Technician test** took effect on July 1, 2022.





(Women Move for Health) on June 11, 2022.



ARES vs ARES de Mark (AK3M)



Yes, you read that right but what does it mean? The LVARC members have been exposed to ARES because we provide communications support to several local agencies during the year under ARES. These events are scheduled and announced prior to the event **BUT** there is another side to ARES. The "E" in ARES means EMERGENCY. We cannot forget that ARES has an emergency component. I was reminded of this when I read the article in the July 2022 issue of QST (page 62) about Brevard County in Florida. The BEARS (Brevard Emergency Amateur Radio Services) is revamping their ARES program to include that their members have ICS certifications.

Although the ARRL ARES program does not require any certification, the LVARC ARES members are strongly encouraged to complete the ICS 100 and ICS 700 certifications to be involved with LV ARES. LVARC RACES does require these ICS certifications. We cannot ignore the fact that a local emergency may require Lehigh Valley ARES activation. After all, that is one reason we have a Monday Night Net!
