

AMATEUR RADIO OPERATOR

• Radio and television stations may be issued personalized registration plates containing the station call letters assigned by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC).

• One registration plate will be issued with your FCC assigned call sign. If you desire a second Amateur Radio Operator registration plate, your FCC call sign plus a hyphen and the #2 will be issued. A copy of your Amateur Radio Station License must be attached. No other personalization is available.

• Fee is \$11.
