Your First Amateur Radio!

(de Mark - AK3M)

We all remember our first pet, our first car or our first love but do you remember your first amateur radio? Maybe you had a tube radio, a transceiver, a separate receiver and transmitter, an HT or a newer radio, VHF/UHF or HF.

Share your first ham radio with the group. Send a picture and/or description of your **first** amateur radio to me for inclusion in the VOX. You need not still have the radio to remember it and send it to me for the VOX.

My first amateur radio was a Heathkit HW-16 CW transceiver (pictured above). I built it from a kit in 1968. It was CW ONLY, crystal controlled transmit frequencies and 75 watts output. There was a VFO available and the radio's maximum power output was 90 watts but both the VFO and 90 watts were not available to an operator with a Novice license.

My first contact was on CW and my first station worked was in Minot, N.D. using a homemade dipole.

I remember that the operator was very patient and kind to a new Novice and adjusted his code speed to match mine! He knew I was a Novice as that was reflected in my call. My call was WN3KIF, the "N" meaning Novice. After passing the General test, the "N" was replaced by an, "A." At that time, one had only two years to upgrade from Novice or lose his license.


