





Spring Antenna Check!

de Mark (AK3M)

Spring is a good time to check any Winter antenna damage and make repairs or replacements.

My VHF/UHF vertical suffered damage over ok the Winter and needed replacement.

A broken vertical does not do well on simplex or through the repeater.









