





On hehalf of Scotty Redfield and in remembrance of his lovely wife Sue, the Jose Fin Foundation sincerely thanks you for your donation to our cause. My husband Erik and I met Sue and Scotty over 25 years ago at a marriage enrichment class at Bethany Church. For the last few years, Sue was an usher with Erik at our Bam church service.

When our 25-year-old daughter Jess was first diagnosed with brain cancer in 2018, one of my co-workers asked me if she could put Jess's name on the recipient list for her Book of Ruth club - this club is a group of Individuals who pray for and send cards of encouragement to those in need. I know Scotty joins me in praying and hooing for a cure someday for the disease that has taken our loved ones.
