


QSTs Looking for a Good Home!

Participating in a Simplex Net

There are many reasons people pursue an amateur radio license. Some are looking at preparedness and back up emergency communications; others may be interested in serving the community through ARES; and still others may be exploring technical aspects of the hobby. No matter what flavor of amateur operator you are, there is something for everyone on a simplex net.

The LVARC has a dedicated 2 meter simplex net that starts at 8pm local time, Thursday nights, on frequency 147.42. The main purpose of that net is to share thoughts and ideas with other hams in the club. The net is not limited to club members and we occasionally have local and some distant hams join our net. The topics range from soup to nuts, and can often be general conversation or a technical topic may be the focus of the discussion.


What are some other purposes for a simplex net? The amateur that is interested in emergency or redundant communications may not only enjoy the net but will have a really good idea on the capabilities of their radio and station set-up. Knowing with whom you can communicate during a normal night is one thing you don't have to wonder about during an emergency. Those that like to experiment may join this type of net to test a different radio, or antenna to evaluate performance.

Net participation of any kind will improve your skills as an operator. Regular net participants develop good communication skills and even better listening skills. Participants also gain familiarity with the limits of their equipment and learn how to leverage those limits for better communications.

If you have never participated in a simplex net because of a perceived equipment limitation, tune in to determine who you can hear. If you are using a hand-held, can you move to a different floor or side of your residence to see what changes occur? Have you considered hooking your HT up to a mobile mag-mount antenna and placing that on a metal surface such as a baking sheet? Can you place a roll-up J-pole in your window during the net? Remember, it takes 10 watts to get to the horizon. You can extend your distance by adding more gain (better antenna), more height (the horizon is now a greater distance), or more power (5 watts to 10 watts is essentially 3dB of gain relative to the listener's radio). While power is not usually an option and is a limiting factor, it's not the best solution. Gain and height are better and easier to accomplish.

Give simplex a try!


