
At the July 20 2025 test session, 2 tested and 2 passed.

#### **ARES Report**

The LVARC will not be providing communications support for the Hannover Township 5K this year. The township has not yet made a commitment to providing an ambulance for the event.

#### 4:Communications:

Website: The board member e-mail addresses have been removed from the website and the VOX. This is due to recent bogus e-mails being sent out. The presentations have been moved to the members' area.

#### **5:Repeater report**: by Rod N3XG.

The issue with the keying up on the 94 repeater could possibly be coming from the Slatington voter. Rod contacted Chris Kelly about the issue. The other repeaters are working fine.

#### 6:Club Station / Trailer:

The trailer will be taken to get serviced after Field Day. One issue is finding someone to tow it. If you have a vehicle that can handle a small trailer that doesn't have brakes and has towing experience, please contact Rod (N3XG).

The fire company has some concerns with the antennas on the roof. Rod will attend a fire company meeting to discuss the concerns

#### 7: Old Business:

The MOU that Lehigh County is requesting is in the hands of the solicitor. The club agreed to increase the liability insurance. The club declined to get workmans comp for the members. Rod will follow up with more info when it becomes available.

The proposed by-law changes were sent out via e-mail and posted in the June VOX.

Rod read the changes for the second time. Rod asked for a motion to accept the proposed by-law changes. A motion was made by Steve (KS3RO) and seconded by John (AB3LZ). The motion passed. The secretary will make the necessary changes.

The N3FJP logging software is on the club computers. They just need the club info added. Final touches will be done at the hands-on night. They will be ready for Field Day.

We are less than a month from Field Day. The portalet and the hand washing station has been reserved. The company quoted a price of \$285. Rod wasn't sure if that was for one day or both. The company will send him an invoice. Paul looked at last year's price and it is close to this years. Rod will ask for a motion undern new business.

John stated that Kirkland Village has not gotten back to him. Right now, it's a done deal unless they contact John.

The board had it's quarterly meeting. One of the topics was the Flex Radio. A lot was discussed. It's a great asset to the club. It gives the opportunity to members who do not have HF capabilities at home. As things progress, Rod will let us know.
